

**Mill Road Primary  
2024-2025 Pre-Kindergarten  
Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q: Is my child eligible for Mill Road Primary Pre-K program?**

**A: If your child is turning 4 on or before December 1<sup>st</sup> of 2024 and they reside within the RHCS D boundaries, then they may apply for the program.**

**Q: What is the schedule for the program?**

**A: Our Pre-K program follows the district calendar and runs the same hours as our primary school – M-F 9:00-3:05.**

**Q: Is transportation provided?**

**A: Students who are 4 years old may ride district transportation. 3-year-old students enrolled in the program must be parent/guardian transported until they turn 4 years old.**

**Q: How many students are in the class?**

**A: MRP offers 2 Pre-K classes with a maximum of 15 students in each class.**

**Q: What is the instructional approach of the program?**

**A: As a public school, we follow NYS Pre-Kindergarten learning standards. Learning is hands-on and focuses on fine motor, gross motor, interpersonal, and academic skills.**

**Q: How are applications selected for the program?**

**A: If more applicants apply than there are spots, a random lottery will be held to pick students for enrollment.**

**Q: How will I know if my child was selected?**

**A: All applicants will be notified of their status in May. If your child is selected, you will be asked to set up an appointment for registration. Selected students are not considered enrolled until they have been fully registered and provided proof of age and residency.**
