

**RED HOOK CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT  
MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING SEPTEMBER 7, 2018**

The regular meeting of the Board of Education was called to order by President Moore at 8:30 a.m. in the K-2 Library at the Mill Road Elementary School followed by the Pledge to the Flag. Board members present were: K. Kortbus, J. Moore, J. Munn (arrived at 8:32 a.m.) and M. Rothwell. D. Morrison was absent. Administration present were: P. Finch, B. Martin, K. Summers, and E. Maskell, District Clerk. **CALL TO ORDER**

Motion made by Kate Kortbus and seconded by Maggie Rothwell that the following personnel item be approved upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools: **PERSONNEL**

1. Appoint Robert McKiernan to the position of full-time (1.0 FTE) High School Principal, to be paid at a pro-rated salary of \$143,000 per year, with a four-year probationary term commencing on October 8, 2018 tentatively scheduled to conclude on October 8, 2022, in the tenure area of Administration, contingent upon his successful completion of the probationary term and having received composite or overall APPR ratings of either "Effective" or "Highly Effective" in at least three of the four preceding years and a rating higher than "Ineffective" at the conclusion of the 2021-2022 school year. **ADMINISTRATOR APPOINTMENT**

All were in favor with none opposed. Motion carried. 4-0 with one Member absent.

Motion made by Maggie Rothwell and seconded by Kate Kortbus to approve the following: That the Board of Education move to Executive Session at 8:34 AM for the purpose of discussing the employment history of a particular individual(s) **EXEC SESSION**
