COMPLAINTS AND POLICIES

Complaints about school board policies should be directed towards the Superintendent of Schools. Complaints shall be in writing, stating the specific objections to the specific policy(ies).

The Superintendent shall review any complaint and conduct whatever study or investigation he/she deems appropriate. The Superintendent shall then submit the complaint and his recommendation to the Board. The Board shall then review the policy, amend or repeal the policy, if appropriate, and notify the complainant of the action taken.
