POLICY # 2000

Board Operational Goals

In order to assure that its operations support the educational philosophy of the district, Policy #000, the Board hereby establishes as its goals:

1. to identify the educational needs and aspirations of the community, and to transform such needs and aspiration into policies aimed at stimulating the students and the learning process;
2. to provide leadership in order that the goals and objectives of the school system, as set forth by the Board, can be effectively carried out;
3. to employ a Superintendent of schools capable of ensuring that the district maintains a position as an outstanding school system and that school personnel carry out the policies of the Board with energy and dedication';
4. to formulate Board policies which best serve the educational interest of students and provide the Superintendent with sufficient and adequate guidelines for implementation;
5. to develop and provide data useful to the planning, evaluation, organization and execution of Board management functions;
6. to perform all Board functions and operations in conformity with state, federal and local laws, rules, and regulation; and
7. to evaluate the Board's performance in relation to these goals, and to establish and clarify policies based upon the results of such evaluation.
