Advisory Committees

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of involving citizens in the development of district policy and in the making of decisions concerning the district. The Board also recognizes that the citizens of the district possess expertise which may be of assistance to the Board in its deliberations.

When the Board determines that an advisory committee should be established it shall establish the specific topic of study and areas of activity of the committee, the individuals who will be invited to serve on the committee and the committee's duration.

The president of the Board shall be an ex officio member of all advisory committees and shall invite those individuals chosen by the Board to serve on a committee. Advisory committees will be dissolved at the completion of their tasks.
