## POLICY # 2382

### Broadcasting and Taping of Board Meetings

The use of any tape recording device at public meetings of a Board of Education is permissible as long as the device is unobtrusive and will not distract from the true deliberative process of the Board. The Board President shall be informed prior to the meeting that such recordings are being made. The Board, in addition, reserves the right to direct that a tape recording be made to ensure a reliable accurate, and complete account of Board meetings.
