Dear Red Hook Central School District Community

Today the Red Hook Central School District received notification of **a positive COVID-19 case for a staff member at the Mill Road Intermediate School**. After consulting with Dutchess County Department of Health, this individual is currently isolated, and due to federal health privacy laws, further information about their Identity or condition cannot be released. We are working collaboratively with the Dutchess County Department of Health on this incident.

All the students and staff at Mill Road Intermediate School that were in contact with the staff member have been notified. ***Due to staffing shortages at Mill Road Intermediate School, we will pivot to remote learning for grades 3-5 for December 21-23.***

As a reminder, all PreK-5 students will pivot to remote learning for December 21-23.

It is imperative that all families remember the following:

- If your child shows any symptoms of COVID-19, it is essential that you keep your child home.
- If your child tests positive for COVID-19, families must notify the school so we can follow our contact tracing protocols.
- If you or a member of your family are COVID positive, or are awaiting test results, please keep your child home.
