Dear Red Hook Central School District Community:

All schools are expected to return to the hybrid model as of Monday, January 25, 2021. Please monitor your email this weekend for any updates.

We appreciate your vigilance with the guidelines below:

- **If your child tests positive for COVID-19, families must notify the school so we can follow our contact tracing protocols.**
- **If you or a member of your family are COVID positive, or are awaiting test results, please keep your child home.**

Today, the Red Hook Central School District received notification of **a positive COVID-19 result for a Facilities/Maintenance Staff Member.** The staff member has not been in attendance since January 15th; therefore, no further action needs to be taken by the school district. As a result, this individual is currently isolated, and due to federal health privacy laws, further information about their Identity or condition cannot be released. We are working collaboratively with the Dutchess County Department of Health, and as always, the safety of our students and staff is our highest priority.
