Dear Red Hook Central School District Community:

Today the Red Hook Central School District received notification of **a symptomatic epi-linked (presumed positive) COVID-19 student at Mill Road Primary School.** After consulting with Dutchess County Department of Health, this individual is currently isolated, and due to federal health privacy laws, further information about their Identity or condition cannot be released. We are working collaboratively with the Dutchess County Department of Health on this incident.

All affected students and staff at Mill Road Primary School that were in contact with the student have been notified. Mill Road Primary School will continue their hybrid schedule tomorrow, Wednesday, February 10th.

It is imperative that all families remember the following:

- If your child shows any symptoms of COVID-19, it is essential that you keep your child home.
- If your child tests positive for COVID-19, families must notify the school so we can follow our contact tracing protocols.
- If you or a member of your family are COVID positive, or are awaiting test results, please keep your child home.
