**Dear Red Hook Central School District Community:**

Today the Red Hook Central School District received notification of **two positive COVID-19 results for students at the Red Hook High School, and one symptomatic epi-linked (presumed positive) result for another student at the Red Hook High School.** As a result, these individuals are currently isolated, and due to federal health privacy laws, further information about their Identity or condition cannot be released. We are working collaboratively with the Dutchess County Department of Health, and as always, the safety of our students and staff is our highest priority.

All affected students and staff at the High School have been notified. **Please be advised that the Red Hook High School will pivot to remote for grades 9-12 during the period of January 20<sup>th</sup> through January 22<sup>nd</sup>.** Presently Mill Road Primary, Linden Avenue Middle School, and the Red Hook High School are all remote for the remainder of this week (January 20-22). High School Building Administration will follow up with information on the educational program including BOCES.
