Dear Red Hook Central School District Community:

The Red Hook Central School District received notification of three positive test results as follows: a **positive COVID-19 result for student at Red Hook High School, a positive COVID-19 result for a student at Mill Road Primary School, and a positive COVID-19 result for an employee in the Transportation Department.** As a result, these individuals are currently isolated, and due to federal health privacy laws, further information about their Identity or condition cannot be released. We are working collaboratively with the Dutchess County Department of Health, and as always, the safety of our students and staff is our highest priority. The students above have not been in attendance since December 18th, and the employee has not been in attendance since December 22nd, therefore, no contact tracing needed to be conducted by the school district based on date of test or onset of symptoms.
