

The following is a message from the Red Hook Central School District
December 18, 2020

Dear Red Hook Central School District Community:

Today the Red Hook Central School District received notification of two cases, **a symptomatic student epi-linked to a confirmed positive COVID-19 (presumed positive) at Mill Road Primary School, and a positive COVID-19 student at Mill Road Intermediate School.** After consulting with Dutchess County Department of Health, these individuals are currently isolated, and due to federal health privacy laws, further information about their Identity or condition cannot be released. We are working collaboratively with the Dutchess County Department of Health on this incident.

All affected students and staff at Mill Road Primary School have been notified. ***Due to staffing shortages at Mill Road Primary School, we will pivot to remote only for grades PreK-2 during the period of December 21-23.***

The student at Mill Road Intermediate School has not be in attendance since December 11th, therefore no further action needs to be taken.

It is imperative that all families remember the following:

- **If your child shows any symptoms of COVID-19, it is essential that you keep your child home.**
- **If your child tests positive for COVID-19, families must notify the school so we can follow our contact tracing protocols.**
- **If you or a member of your family are COVID positive, or are awaiting test results, please keep your child home.**
